

**MINUTES OF STANLEY AND STANLEY COMMON PARISH COUNCIL**  
**MEETING HELD ON 10 MAY 2016 AT THE SCOUT HUT, STANLEY COMMON**

**14/091 Election of Chair**

Nominations for the office of Chair were invited. Councillor Colonel M Cheetham was nominated. There were no other nominations. **RESOLVE:** Councillor Colonel M Cheetham elected as Chair. All Councillors voted in favour.

**14/092 Election of Vice Chair**

Nominations for the office of Vice Chair were invited. Councillor K Chambers was nominated and proposed. Councillor Rhodes nominated herself however no proposer came forward. **RESOLVE:** Councillor K Chambers was elected as Vice Chair. All Councillors voted in favour with the exception of Councillor Rhodes who abstained.
