

MINUTES OF STANLEY AND STANLEY COMMON PARISH COUNCIL
MEETING HELD ON 16 OCTOBER 2018 AT THE SCOUT HUT, STANLEY COMMON

18/178 Public Speaking

A representative from the Village Hall Committee reported that they had been successful with a grant of 46k from the Garfield Western Anniversary Fund. The Parish Council gave congratulations to the VHC.

A parishioner reported that the Community Speedwatch training on Sunday 14 October was very successful. Colin Tomlinson had offered to take on the role of the Co-ordinator and asked if the Parish Council would consider purchasing a speed gun. It was agreed to include on the next agenda.

Various concerns relating to traffic were reported by parishioners. Councillor Hart confirmed that she is the Derbyshire County Council (DCC) representative for the Parish and was surprised that she had not been invited to the community group meeting as DCC are responsible for highways and not EBC. Councillor Hart has some answers to the Stanley Community Group questions posted on their Facebook page further to their meeting. Councillor Hart passed on her contact details in order to organise this.

A parishioner made comments regarding "No waiting signs" at a bus stop on Station Road, Stanley, but there are on others. Councillor Hart offered to follow this up and contact the Civil Parking Officers at EBC. It was also mentioned that the bus stops are very close together in this area.

A parishioner reported that on Coronation Road and Queens Avenue there are some hedges overhanging the pavement.

Councillor Smith reported that the plumber had completed the work on the showers. A mixer tap was replaced as one was beyond repair. Councillor Smith had met with the treasurer of WHFC who has been given a set of keys. WHFC hope to play in a fortnights time. The updated hire agreement which had been circulated to all Councillors for approval had been signed by WHFC.

Councillor Smith offered to lay the wreath at Stanley Common. Councillor Garton offered to lay the wreath at Stanley if the veteran was not able to attend.

There have been some instances to cause concern regarding car park which is being monitored. Councillors discussed the concerns. The gates will be opened/closed as stated on the sign.

Concerns regarding the mowing of the recreation ground were discussed. A meeting with Countrywide is to be arranged for an explanation to cover these concerns.

It was agreed to ask a pupil from Stanley Common school to switch on the lights at Stanley Common and the gala representatives at Stanley. It was resolved to purchase sweets up to £45 and offer a donation of £50 towards R Arter's charity of choice. It was agreed to make a donation of £50 to the Salvation Army £50 and £40 to SVH for refreshments.
