

**MINUTES OF STANLEY AND STANLEY COMMON PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD
ON 18 October 2016 AT THE SCOUT HUT, STANLEY COMMON**

16/210 Public Speaking

A member of the public thanked Councillor Marshall for painting the handrails around Stanley village hall.

Members of the public have expressed a wish to have a war memorial on public land, that is accessible at all times so they can pay their respects at their convenience. Council has looked into this before but concluded that the cost is too high and there are already two war memorials within the church grounds. Baileys have quoted £2250 for a fitted 6ft pinnacle on a plinth and it is estimated that £3000 would have to be raised by those involved to fully fund the war memorial. Beverly Rhodes has expressed willingness to chair a meeting, independent of the council, with the community to discuss this further and advise on the steps that need to be taken before putting it to council formally. The parish council have agreed to fund the room to accommodate this meeting.

A member of the public has expressed concern about the state of the ground on the verge beside the park in Stanley common where residents are parking and asks if there are any plans to improve this. This area is property of Derbyshire County Council and Councillor Hart has explained that unfortunately, there is no budget to make any improvements.

Councilor hart informed that the community transport services is going to be experimented with when the subsidies are gone.

West Hallam community have been entered into Tesco's 'bags of help' scheme for new play equipment and Councilor Hart has asked that people vote in store for their community project to help them raise as much money as possible between 31st October and 13th November.

16/216 SC football changing rooms update

16/218 EBC Rural Communities Grant Scheme applications

Stanley Village Hall Committee Application submitted for scheme. Only one application has been received by the Parish Council.

16/219 Village Hall Extension/Village Hall Management Agreement update (Councillor Lowe)

Confirmation that funding is in place is required before Management agreement can be signed. The agreement

needs to be finalised with which option is going forward. Royce Drew is prepared to do everything on the village hall committees behalf. Once the footprint is decided on, Royce Drew should draw up a wayleave for the village hall to build outside of its current footprint on the recreation ground.

16/220 Land Registry of fallow field/Stanley & Stanley Common recreation grounds update (Councillor Lowe)

This has been accepted and will be removed from further meetings

16/221 Stanley PF North boundary ditch drainage issues (Councillor Lowe)

It was concluded that the council would write to Mr Willets to organise a meeting.

16/222 West SVPF boundary and blocked ditch in adjoining field adjacent PF boundary hedge (Councillor Lowe)

Pugh Lewis has been contacted to see if there is any movement on a meeting. Councillor Harvey informed that there is another spring coming up near the carpark end of Stanley recreation ground. Mike is going to check with the Clerk what has been done so far towards this and will potentially take over investigating this.

16/223 Stanley Common seat concern (Councillor Rhodes)

Councillors Marshall and Harvey are to go and have a look at the bench to assess what action needs to be taken.

16/224 Play equipment update (Councillor Harvey)

Repairs to the roundabout along with other repairs have now been completed. The roundabout needed additional work including welding which has cost an additional £135 +VAT. Play inspection reports have now been published and these are to be compared by the working party.

16/225 Fallow Field update (Councillor Cheetham)

Councillors Smith and Cheetham have met with Mr. Wooley, who has expressed a wish to discontinue looking after the fallow field. All other farmers approached do not want to take on the field either. Previously, comments have been made about excessive dog mess on the field, however, after inspection, no evidence of dog mess could be found. Mr. Wooley has advised that the field is not well used. Paul from Broomfield has volunteered to trim and maintain the field going forwards, this may be in contention with the work we've asked Steve Jackson to do on the field so Councillor Smith is going to speak with Steve to see if he is happy for Paul to take over these duties.

16/226 Christmas light switch on (Councillor Harvey)

Councillor Harvey has been contacted by Leisure lights and they have informed her that repairs have been made and the lights are ready. A Santa for Stanley Common has been found, the turn on has been organized and the salvation army has been booked for Stanley. A donation is to be given for tea, coffee and a donation for the use the village hall as agreed earlier in the year. It has also been agreed to give a £50 donation to the salvation army and £40 for the sweets. Richard Arter is going to do the music in Stanley Common and Stanley Common school are going to provide someone to turn on the lights. The Gala Princess is going to turn the lights on in Stanley. Vicars have been contacted to do the services. The light turn ons will be on the 2nd December. It has been agreed to give a donation of £20 to Gill for fetching the barriers. Richard Arter is going to be asked to specify an organization to receive a £50 donation in thanks for providing the music for Stanley Commons light turn on.

16/227 Proposal for PC to write to EBC to request dog waste bin/s to be provided for use by village resident dog walkers regularly using the public footpaths and pavements on the south side of Stanley Village (Councillor Lowe)

It has been requested that we place a dog waste bin near the foot path near the school as there is no bins nearby to dispose of dog waste. This bin would have to be maintained by the parish council. Clerk is to write a letter to Derbyshire County Council to see if they would allow a bin to be placed there and to find out costings for getting the bin and emptying it and to find out how often it needs to be emptied and if it is possible to have it emptied less often. Once this information has been obtained, this can be further discussed at a future meeting.

16/228 Grounds Maintenance Contracts

The grounds maintenance contracts are coming up for renewal and so need to be reviewed and renegotiated by the finance working party. All other contracts are also to be reviewed and, if necessary, renewed by the working party.

16/229 Bulls Corner plants (Councillor Harvey)

Residents have kindly cut back the hedge lining the path leading to Stanley recreation ground and have also agreed to maintain this regularly. It has been agreed to spend £60 on plants for bulls head corner in Stanley and Stanley Common bench.
