

**MINUTES OF STANLEY AND STANLEY COMMON PARISH COUNCIL
MEETING HELD ON 20 JUNE 2017 AT THE VILLAGE HALL, STANLEY**

17/132 Declaration of Members Interests

Councillor J Marshall declared an interest in the pre-school fencing request and Councillor Smith in accounts for payment.

17/133 Approval of Minutes

It was resolved that the minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on 16.5.17 should be approved and were signed by the Chairman. All Councillors voted in favour.

17/135 Chairmans Announcements

Councillor Cheetham mentioned about the display in Derby Market Place for Armed forces day this weekend.

17/136 SC football changing rooms

Councillors Rhodes and Harvey to organise a working group meeting.

17/137 Village Hall Extension/Village Hall Management Agreement update

Nothing further to update.

17/138 Stanley Common Defibrillator update

The Chinese takeaway had withdrawn their offer to site the defibrillator on their wall. It was resolved to site the defibrillator on the Stanley Common changing rooms. All Councillors voted in favour except Councillor Rhodes. R Arter had agreed to do the weekly check. Councillor Marshall is organising a training session in conjunction with the Eventide Hall.

17/139 Play equipment update including Cross Chains Stanley Common

The cross chains had broken and this had been cordoned off and an order been placed to repair for £500. It was agreed to contact Countrywide to check that the instruction previously given regarding strimming is being carried out and instruct them to make a wider area of weed killer. It was agreed to obtain a quote and advice on how to treat the trim trail. Further details on wet pour repair/replacement is awaited.

17/140 Fallow Field update

Councillor Cheetham is continuing to progress with Ciswo. Councillor Rhodes made a proposal to do a hay cut on the fallow field in September and that she liaise with S Jackson to organise. There was no seconder. A proposal for the Clerk to ask S Jackson to cut the grass and hedge on the fallow field and the hedge on Stanley recreation ground at the appropriate times was made. All Councillors voted in favour except Councillor Rhodes who objected.

Councillor Rhodes was not happy with the decision and was very vocal about this and said she was going to leave the meeting. Councillor Rhodes was asked to stop raising her voice or the meeting would have to be closed. Councillor Rhodes stopped and confirmed she would stay for the next item.

17/141 Waste bin proposal

The original decision on the siting of the waste bin proposed by Coucillor Lowe had not been carried out due to the interference from Councillor Rhodes who stated that it was her land. Councillor Cheetham had since seen land registry document of who did own the land. Further to the April meeting Councillors Harvey and Marshall had consulted with residents along Derby Road to establish if there was a dog waste/litter problem along this area and potential locations for a bin. The conclusions of the consultation were brought to the PC meeting. Due to the lack of evidence of waste,

alternative locations and objections from parishioners the working party proposed that no further action was taken but to keep the results of the consultation survey for PC records. All Councillors voted in favour except Councillor Rhodes.

Councillor Rhodes proposed a waste bin for Dale Road near the footpath. There was no seconder.

Councillor Rhodes left the meeting.

17/142 Football pitch hire 2017/2018. Request from WHFC 2 teams at Stanley Common Sundays (weekly) and Ilkeston Robins U13's 10.30 alternate Sundays Stanley

All Councillors voted in favour of 2 teams from WHFC on Sundays using Stanley Common recreation ground. It was resolved to charge £140 per team and £75 per team for use of the changing rooms for the season. The working party to review the premises and a site meeting be held with WHFC representatives to discuss the arrangements. WHFC to keep clean and remove any rubbish. All Councillors voted in favour.

A proposal to allow the Ilkeston Robins U13's to use Stanley recreation ground 10.30 am alternative Sundays at a cost £130 for the season was made and all Councillors voted in favour.

It was resolved to send an email to WHFC regarding the lack of response to use of Stanley recreation ground for organised training sessions on Thursday evenings. Stating that payment of £40 for the use of the pitch is required within 28 days or WHFC will not be able to use any pitch next season. All Councillors voted in favour.

17/143 Bench request Belper Road

A request had been made for a bench on Belper Road. It was agreed that the best option for a bench would be inside the bus shelter before Glendon Street going towards Derby. It was noted that the slot for the bench was in the bus shelter but no bench installed. The Clerk had contacted EBC and DCC asking for a bench to be installed and is waiting for a response.

17/144 Stanley Common war memorial update

Councillors offered to clean the Stanley war memorial for the July Wellington Bomber service. A quote is to be obtained to clean for the Remembrance Service in November. The working party will attend the 5 July meeting and report back to Council.
