17/052 Public Speaking

Councillor Hart reported that DCC are regularising road traffic orders and a proposed 30mph speed limit and consolidation order for Derby Road, Stanley had been made as follows:-
to extend the existing 30mph speed limit on Derby Road, Stanley from its existing location outside 136 Derby Road in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 62 metres. The proposed new position coincides with the start of the existing street lighting and the residential properties and to provide one Speed Limit Traffic Regulation Order for Derby Road, Station Road and Cat and Fiddle Lane through Stanley to West Hallam in order to assist the police with their enforcement duties. This is a technical adjustment and no other alteration to the existing speed limits or their position on these roads is proposed. The deadline for comments is the 10 April.
